To enrich the lives of all Washington state residents and businesses by ensuring they have access to affordable, reliable, redundant and scalable/future proof broadband technologies ensuring the economic viability of both urban and rural Washington state today and into the future. It is the goal of the state of Washington under RCW 43.330.536:

- By 2024: 25/3 megabits per second (Mbps) scalable
- By 2026: 1/1 gigabit per second (Gbps) all anchor institutions
- By 2028: 150/150 Mbps all residents and businesses

Criteria for SBO Grant Opportunities per R.C.W. 43.330.530

Broadband Infrastructure Fund:

- Infrastructure Acceleration Grants – Eligible Applicants
 - Local Governments,
 - Public Ports,
 - Public Utility Districts,
 - **Federally Recognized Tribes,**
 - Nonprofit Organizations, and
 - Public-Private Partnerships

2022 Infrastructure Acceleration Grant (IAG) Federal ARPA Capital Funding, approximately \$122M TBD for Applicants

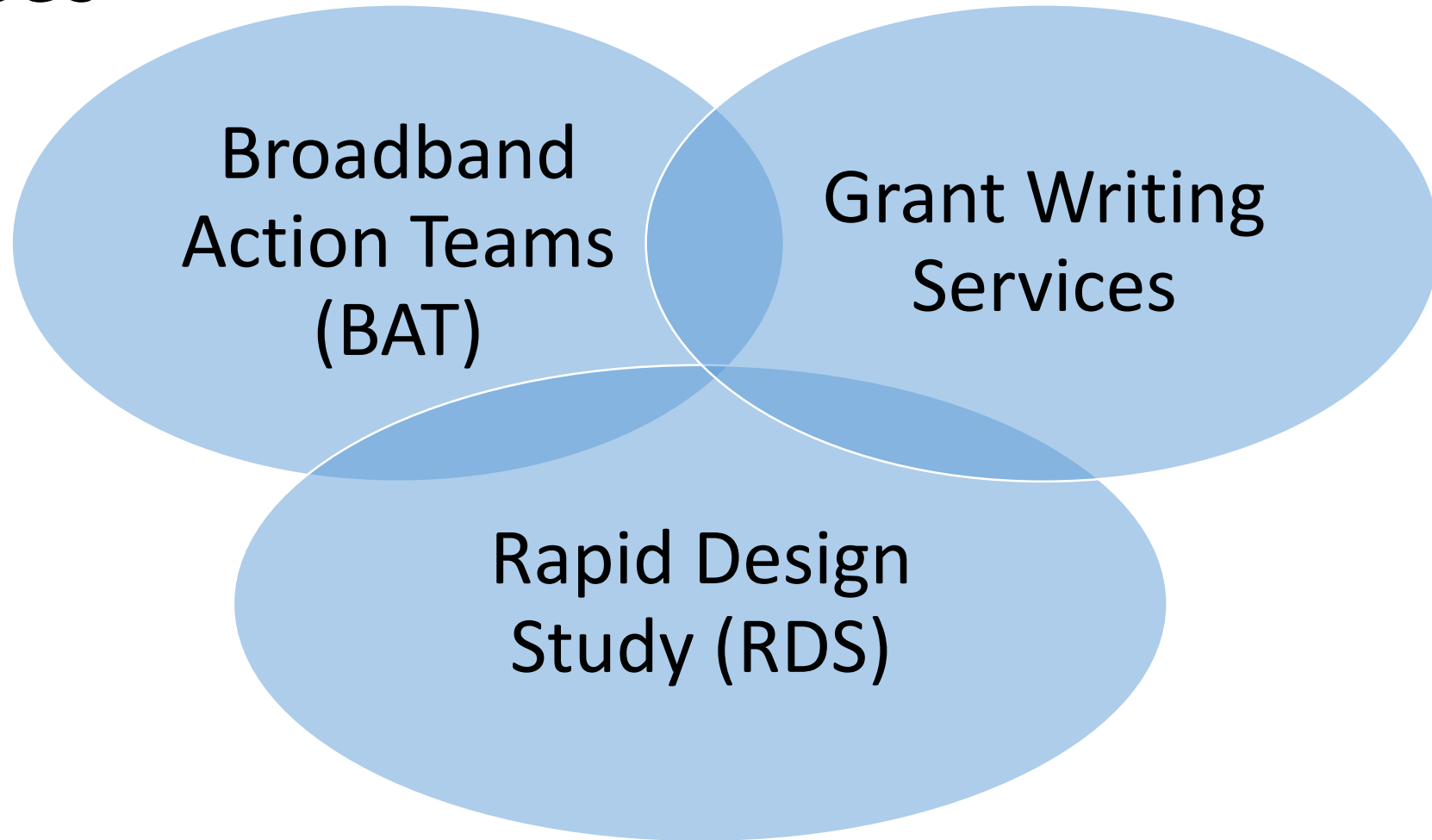
- Available to Eligible Applicants, including Tribes to Construct Last Mile Infrastructure as defined in RCW 43.330.530

\$25M

Matching Grants to Federal Agency application or award

- There is approximately \$ 25 million set-aside for Matching Grant applications. This is an “open cycle” on a first come, first serve basis, until funds are exhausted. Eligible entities applying for federal agency broadband infrastructure funding.

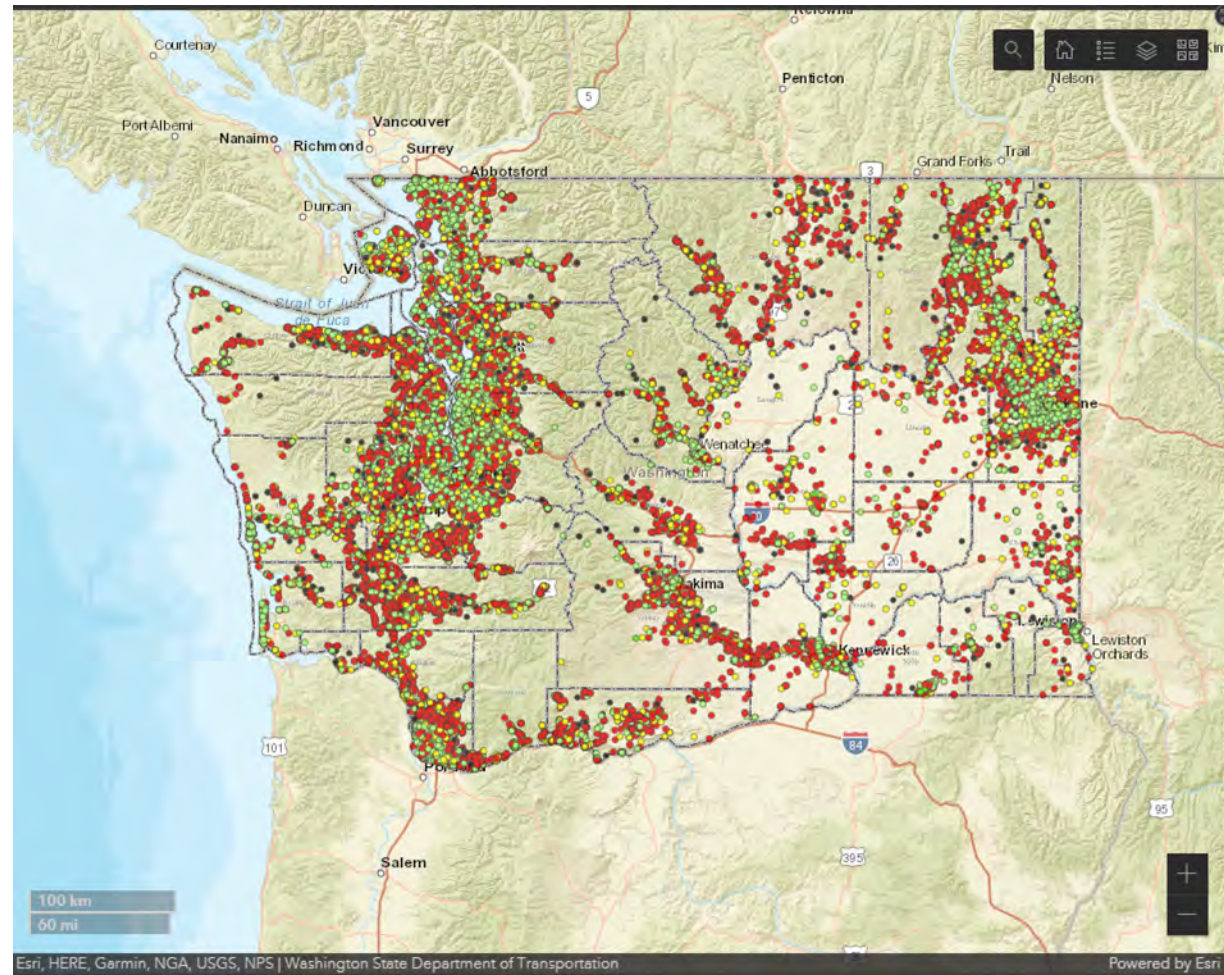
